Joyce Van Tuyl's explanation: I felt like I needed a limit because 2 of the parks have only 5 sites left. I guess if you still want to go on the Rolling Rally, tell them you're not one of the 12, and you're an extra. The park in Roland, OK will not hold our sites, so you must book your sites in advance. So, if you still want to go, it's fine with me, if you book a site and tell them you're not one of the 12. I didn't think we would have more than 12 go.

Did everyone understand that it's the size of the parks?

It will be hot. We didn't think we would have that many who wanted to attend.

Evelyn Lee: Same rallies, same places. Not having a welcome bag for everywhere rally? Host needs to be more in charge of the decision of whether or not to have a bag.
